General Info

Airport

Taxi: Once you reach the airport, you can get a taxi to your hotel. There is no need to call or book a taxi; they are already outside the arrival. The taxi should cost less than 30 euros to get to any address in Chiaia.

Travel duration: 20 minutes

Bus: You can take a bus called Alibus. I would ask at the airport if you can buy the ticket on the bus. Otherwise, you can buy it at the airport in a store called SUN STORE. Please ask someone at the airport to show you where it is. The ticket should cost you 5 euros.





To Visit

Naples is a vibrant city with so much to offer, and spending your first day in the Chiaia neighborhood will give you a fantastic introduction to its culture, charm, and history. Here's a guide to help you make the most of your day in Chiaia, Naples:

Morning

- Start at Via Chiaia
- Begin your day walking down Via Chiaia, a lively and picturesque street that connects the upscale shopping area of Chiaia with the heart of Naples. You'll find a mix of elegant boutiques, cafés, and historic buildings along the way. It's perfect for a morning stroll, and you'll also catch glimpses of local life.
- Stop at Piazza del Plebiscito
- At the end of Via Chiaia, you'll reach Piazza del Plebiscito, one of Naples' most iconic squares. Take some time to admire the stunning architecture here, like the Royal Palace of Naples and the Church of San Francesco di Paola, which has a beautiful neoclassical design. The square is also a great spot for people-watching and taking in the vibrant atmosphere of the city.
- Explore Around Piazza del Plebiscito After enjoying the square, explore the surrounding landmarks:

Thing to visit

After a nice meal, you'll be all set to dive back into exploring. Here are a few suggestions for what you can do next in Naples to keep the afternoon vibe going:

Afternoon

-Start at Castel dell'Ovo

Spend about 45 minutes to an hour here. You can explore the castle, enjoy the views of the bay, and maybe take a little walk along the seafront promenade if the weather is nice. It's a peaceful spot to begin your tour.

Head to Galleria Borbonica

-After Castel dell'Ovo, it's a short drive or walk to Galleria Borbonica. Allow about 1 hour for a guided tour (highly recommended to get the full historical context). The underground space is unique, and it can be a cool, mysterious experience.

If you feel like an ice cream you can stop to Gelateria Mennella (Lito's favourite) on Via carducci 50/52 or Gelatiere (My favourite) on Via San Pasquale 15.

-Next, visit Villa Pignatelli

After emerging from the depths of Galleria Borbonica, you can head over to Villa Pignatelli. Spend about 45 minutes to an hour walking through the gardens and the museum, enjoying the architecture and atmosphere.

-Finish at Metro San Pasquale

End your afternoon by visiting the Metro station. It's a quick stop to admire the contemporary art and design. You could also take the metro from here if you're headed to another part of the city afterward!

Thing to visit

The Old Town of Naples, or Centro Storico, is a UNESCO World Heritage site full of history, culture, and charm. There's so much to explore! Here are some must-dos when visiting:

Morning

- -If you walk to the Old Town (centro storico) and you pass by Via toledo metro station, I suggest you to visit.
- -Start from Piazza del Gesù Nuovo Begin by taking in the vibrant atmosphere of the square. This is one of the city's most famous spots, known for its striking baroque architecture. The Chiesa del Gesù Nuovo (Church of Jesus New) is the main highlight here, with its unique façade made of diamond-shaped stones. You can head inside to admire the impressive interior and the frescoes that adorn the church.
- -Chiostro di Santa Chiara From Piazza del Gesù Nuovo, it's just a short walk to the Chiostro di Santa Chiara (Cloister of Santa Chiara). This peaceful spot is part of the Monastery of Santa Chiara, and it's absolutely beautiful. The cloister features vibrant, hand-painted majolica tiles depicting scenes of nature and rural life, which give it a very Mediterranean feel. The courtyard is tranquil, and you can take your time to explore the peaceful gardens and the monastery's small museum. It's a great place to pause and absorb the historic surroundings. While you're here, also consider visiting the Santa Chiara Church nearby, which has an impressive baroque interior and a stunning altarpiece.
- -Walk towards Cappella Sansevero to see the Cristo Velato (Veiled Christ), one of the most iconic sculptures in the world. Booking ahead is highly recommended for this small chapel, as it can get quite busy. The veiled sculpture, with its exquisite detail, is a must-see.
- -Explore the fascinating Napoli Sotterranea (Underground Naples), a guided tour through the ancient tunnels beneath the city. You'll discover Roman-era streets, water cisterns, and old Greek ruins that are hidden beneath the city's surface.



Transformed in 1742 by Domenico Antonio Vaccaro, the garden is dotted with citrus fruit trees and majolica-tiled columns and pergolas.

Afternoon

- -Spaccanapoli A narrow, bustling street running through the heart of the historic center. It's lined with churches, pizzerias, and artisan shops. It's a great place to immerse yourself in the local culture and try authentic Neapolitan pizza
- Naples Cathedral (Duomo di Napoli) This magnificent cathedral, dedicated to Saint Januarius (San Gennaro), is a must-see. Don't miss the Chapel of San Gennaro, where the famous miracle of the liquefaction of the saint's blood takes place.
- Via San Gregorio Armeno Known for its traditional Nativity scene workshops. It's a must-see, especially around Christmas, but even year-round, the handcrafted figurines are unique and make for great souvenirs.

For contemporary art lovers, the Museo d'Arte Contemporanea Donna Regina (MADRE) is a must-see. It showcases a wide array of modern works by international and Italian artists.

- Museo Filangeri

Housed in an 18th-century palace, this museum showcases a collection of Neapolitan art and antiques, including porcelain, furniture, and paintings. It's a great spot for those looking to experience local art and craftsmanship.





Thing to visit

Vomero is a charming neighborhood in Naples, offering a mix of beautiful views, historical sites, and vibrant culture. Here are some mustvisit spots in Vomero:

Morning

Villa Floridiana: A lovely park with expansive gardens and a peaceful atmosphere, perfect for a stroll or a relaxing afternoon. Inside the villa, there's a museum of decorative arts. If too hot you can stop to their outdoor cafeteria.

- Piazza Vanvitelli: This is the heart of Vomero, a lively square surrounded by cafes and shops. The iconic Funicolare (cable car) station connects Vomero to the lower parts of Naples.
- Via Scarlatti: This is the main shopping street in Vomero, full of boutiques, local stores, and cafes. It's a great place to wander, shop, and experience the local vibe.
- -Castel Sant'Elmo A historic fortress offering panoramic views of Naples and the Bay of Naples. It's an iconic site in Vomero and has great exhibitions and a rich history to explore.
- -Certosa di San Martino This former monastery now houses a museum showcasing art, religious artifacts, and offering another spectacular view of the city. The architecture and surrounding gardens are also beautiful to stroll through.





Mount Vesuvius Level Moderate

Duration: 1.5 - 2 hours
